Micro-credentials and ECCOE project

Nowadays there is a growing need for an open, online and flexible higher education. This requires, from one side, the need of new educational formats (not only bachelor and master but *shorter* learning programmes), and, from the other, the demand of recognizing and assessing prior knowledge. In this context ECCOE-European the Credit Clearinghouse for Opening up Educationis positioned, which has the main purpose of developing an "ECCOE-system" for the recognition of digital credentials. The consortium is composed of six partners, including EADTU, coordinated by the French AUNEGe - Université Numérique Economie Gestion. The kick-off was in September 2019 and the partners have three years ahead.

1st Convention on MOOCs for the Labour market

On Wednesday, December 18th, these stakeholders have met together for the 1st time in a convention organized by EADTU in Brussels. At this event the potential of MOOC offerings for the labour market and the Common Microcredential Framework (CMF) were discussed as part of integrating MOOCs and MOOC-based programmes in the educational and training system.
