Shaping education in the era of COVID-19: A MOOC responding to the urgent needs of teachers in primary and secondary school education

Because of the corona-virus pandemic more and more institutions are closing campuses and move their classes online. The pandemic also led the Greek government to declare a state of country lock-down keeping all schools and educational institutions closed for over a month requesting that classes should be moved completely online for Higher Educational Institutes (HEIs) but also partly for primary and secondary education institutions. While HEIs adapted rather easily to this situation due to the higher degree of practicing e-learning methodologies, the new educational framework turned out to be hard to be adopted by schoolteachers. Therefore the Educational Content, Methodology and Technology Laboratory of the Hellenic Open University in collaboration with the Institute of Educational Policy of the Greek Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs developed a MOOC presenting all required methodologies and practices of e-learning focusing on the training of schoolteachers and providing them with practical guidelines for succeeding in their new assignments that urgently the pandemic shaped. The MOOC will be made available in the first week of May 2020 and can be accessed here.



The UOC celebrates 25 years

25 years ago, on April 6, the Catalan Parliament unanimously passed a law to create the UOC. In the words of the UOC's founding president, Gabriel Ferraté: "We wanted to use new technology to break down the barriers of time and space." In a world of landlines, dial-up modems and no Google, the Universitat Oberta de Catalunya arrived in this world to become the first ever university

to be fully online. Over the years, the UOC has built a community of people who are connecting their talent to transform society. Today, 25 years later, everything has changed. We're remembering these roots despite the difficulties we're all going through – a situation that's challenging our ability to respond as a community to the crisis that hit us.

The UOC's Emergency Remote Teaching initiative

The UOC responds to the global emergency situation with a training proposal that accompanies university professors as well as secondary and professional training teachers to implement remote solutions to their teaching.

Since April 6th, coinciding with its 25th anniversary, the UOC makes its knowledge and experience in virtual education available through a series of webinars and MOOCs with the aim of accompanying teachers who require it so that they can implement a contingency plan for the crisis in their compulsory distance teaching.

DCU Launches First Credit Earning Micro-credential

In February, Dublin City University's (DCU) launched a new online, stackable, credit-earning microcredential as part of its global strategic partnership with FutureLearn. This exciting new initiative in the rapidly growing area of Fintech draws on the European Common Framework for Microcredentials launched last year with leadership from EADTU and DCU plans to launch further fully online, credit-bearing micro-credentials over the next year. DCU's first micro-credential recognises that the rise of Financial Technologies (Fintech) is opening the world to a host of new possibilities but also creating both business and organisational challenge in the financial sector.
