MOOCs and Short Learning Programmes

In a fast-changing world, MOOCs respond to the future needs of employers and employees for a flexible updating of knowledge and skills. MOOC providers have also started with coherent MOOC packages, leading to specific awards e.g. FutureLearn Programmes, Coursera Specialisations and edX's MicroMasters.

These new offerings will also be examined under the **European Short Learning Programmes (E-SLP)** project, started by EADTU and 14 university partners. This project focusses on the implementation of certified online/blended SLPs. Credits, certificates and diplomas are to be related to the European Qualification Framework. In this context, it is relevant to consider the value of credits for MOOCs to be eventually integrated in SLPs.



These new courses were realized thanks to a cooperation among UNINETTUNO and the North-Eastern Federal University of Yakutsk, Siberian Transport University of Novosibirsk, Irkutsk National Research Technical University, Tuvan State University of Kyzyl, Far Eastern Federal University of Vladivostok, Harbin Institute of Technology and Dalian University of Technology, in the framework of the Erasmus+ European project, “**LPEB**”.
