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It can, for example, relate to hybrid, blended or online distance learning, development of digital skills, e-assessment, micro-credentials and continuing education, digital collaboration, mobility in transmational course/programmes, quality assurance and institutional policies/conditions for digital education.

Meta-research on the learner perspective on micro-credential formats and learning services for continuing education and professional development in the MCE project. EADTU is contributing to the further conceptualization of micro-credentials and to transformative institutional developments in interaction with national and EU policies and frameworks.

Recently, an outcome has been published which presents a systematic literature review investigating the learner's perspective towards micro-credentials format, taking into consideration the research carried out in the last five years. After applying the PRISMA methodology, a total of 48 papers were included.
