JYU pioneers biodiversity footprint calculation

The University of Jyväskylä collaborated with the third largest city in Finland, Tampere, to calculate the biodiversity and carbon footprints of the city organisation. The result shows for the first time the impact to biodiversity caused by a large urban organisation. The footprints were calculated using a methodology developed by the University of Jyväskylä's Resource Wisdom community, JYUWisdom.
