The Passeport EAD is an essential resource for students entering university or returning to study. The Passeport EAD is a training programme intended for future undergraduate or students resuming higher education who wish to pursue university studies online. It must be done during the summer before starting university. The volume per hour is approximately 65 hours minimum. It is made up of existing courses taught by different French universities. Some universities also use the Passeport EAD all year round for students when needs are detected.

UNINETTUNO AND SOS - School of Sustainability ready for the start Master Degree in sustainable architecture. Global blended program for the architects of the future

Italy, USA, Canada, Philippines, Armenia, India, Lebanon and Brazil are the countries of origins of young architects enrolled to the first intake of the new Blended Master program (online and in presence in Milan) created by the global Guru of sustainable architecture Mario Cucinella and UNINETTUNO University. Starting from September 2024 students can engage in online courses on sustainability practices and participate in hands-on project work at MCA - Mario Cucinella Architects headquarter in Milan.

The program requires a Bachelor's Degree in Architecture or Engineering. Thanks for his specificity and the involvement of top industrial partners, the Master will offer a highly employable rate, with 88% securing jobs within two months. The new program is part of the Uninettuno Green initialive, a strategic line of didactic and research focused on ecological transition, climate change, and sustainability: an initiative inspired by the Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations' 2030 Agenda and the new European Green Deal.



Erasmus+ Staff Week at Universidade Aberta

Universidade Aberta of Portugal organized a new edition of the Erasmus Staff Week from the 24th to the 28th June. This year, more than three dozen representatives from 24 universities from nine European countries were welcome: Bulgaria, France, Greece, Hungary, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Spain and Turkey. This week offered participants an opportunity not only to get to know further Universidade Aberta, its specific virtual pedagogical model and organizational structure, but also to establish new contacts useful for future partnerships, research projects and new Erasmus mobility flows.

Microcredentials: the UOC's bold move to boost employability

The UOC is launching 64 microcredentials in its 30th academic year to enhance employability. These short, specialized courses, worth up to six credits, validate professional skills in fields such as health, communication, law, and computer science. The certificates can be shared via CVs and social media, helping students upskill or reskill for current and future job markets. UOC's microcredentials represent a "model for lifelong learning" that considers recognition, traceability, and complementary factors across various levels, fostering mobility and hybridization. This initiate aligns with UOC's mission to provide support for individual and collective needs in a globally aware society.

How to successfully integrate learning analytics and AI in education?

The UOC and Ramon Lluil University are leading a two-year research project to study the use of learning analytics and AI in education. The project aims to create general guidelines to maximize these technologies benefits and personalize education. Researchers will examine their implementation in Catalan secondary schools, assessing data management and generative AI practices. The goal is to provide ethical practical guidelines for teachers and policymakers. The project seeks to improve pedagogical practices, address educational inequalities, inclusion and academic failure and support personalized learning. The findings are expected to be adaptable to other educational stages or geographical area.
