MCE has two new reports published! EADTU's project MCE - Modularization of Continuing Education and Micro-credentials has recently published two reports.

The first, compiled by UNINETTUNO and UNED on case studies on modularization and micro-credentialing, presents 19 case studies collected within the partnership, and proposes as et of 9 dimensions to be taken into consideration for the next phase of the project: piloting.

The other report maps and analyzes existing institutional qualifications for continuing education and professional development and depict learners' preferences based on the data collected within MCE. It has been compiled by FernUniversitä in Hagen involving all the HEs in the MCE partnership: UNINETTUNO, UNED, Universidade Aberta, Hellenic Open University, Open Universitel, Open University of Cyprus, Kaunas University of Technology, Open University of Catalunya, and KU Leuven.

The summit built on the EU council Recommendation on micro-credentials, finding ways to use this legislative basis as an instrument to accelerate adoption, acceptance and recognition of short-form education across the continent and beyond.

New online courses on biodiversity loss In spring 2023, the Open University of the University of Jyväskylä introduces two new courses on how and why species and ecosystems are increasingly becoming threatened, and how threat status is assessed.

The free-of-charge Nature Under Threat online courses provide insight into the ecological and social phenomena surrounding endangerment.

"Endangerment is an ecological fact that carries many implications for society. These courses delve into the deterioration of nature in light of the latest scientific research and explore conservation methods that have been found to be effective," says Postdoctoral Researcher Kaisa Raatikainen, who created the new studies.

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From Hyperconnectivity to AI Wireless communication systems and digital technologies have transformed our society to such an extent that it now seems almost impossible to live without Wi-FI or a smartphone. The accelerated digitalization of our world has led to many advances, but it has also come with an increase in energy consumption and environmental impact. What if using networks for more than just communications could contribute to real sustainability in the digital world?

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Are micro-credentials the future? Finish school, study for a bachelor's degree, specialize through a master's degree or postgraduate qualification and then begin to work. This traditional linear route taken by higher education, which culminates and perhaps ends forever with the securing of a job. is increasingly coming into question, as it fails to meet the needs and demands of today's employment ecosystem.

'Micro-credentials', is the new buzzword. They certify learning outcomes provide flexible and personalized help for people in acquiring the knowledge, skills and competencies they need for their personal and professional development, quickly and efficiently.
