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New UOC AI system lets the university monitor online students at risk of dropping out

The University of Catalonia (UOC) has developed an AI system that identifies students at risk of dropping out. Using machine learning algorithms, the system analyzes academic and behavioral data, detecting patterns indicative of potential disengagement. By recognizing early warming signs, educators can intervene to support struggling students and enhance retention rates. The innovative AI tool exemplifies the application of technology in education to foster student success and address dropout challenges.
